### **HANDY HINTS FOR IMPROVING LEARNING:**

No.3: **Organising a Learning Space for your child-Lighting:**

Natural or indirect lighting such as a desk lamp is best for learning. It is best for your child not to study under fluorescent lighting as it is related to raised cortisol levels in the blood stream (an indicator of anxiety and agitation). Cortisol also suppresses language functions. If you are purchasing a desk lamp try to avoid fluorescent lights.

### WILBERFORCE OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE & VACATION CARE:

This is a non profit community organisation that provides a high quality accredited and varied program for children ages 5 to 12 years during term, before and after school, and during school holiday periods.

They are running an introductory special for the local schools. If you book for the July school holidays, the usual annual enrolment fee of \$40.00 per family will be waived. All you will pay is your daily fee and any excursion costs. Child Care Benefit (CCB) is also available to families. Some examples of savings with CCB are: A family on 50% CCB will pay approximately \$17 for a full day of care, per child. On 75% CCB will only pay approximately \$8 per day, per child and on 100% CCB will only pay approximately \$2 per day, per child.

So come on down and check us out, and grab an enrolment form.

Operating hours are: 7 til 9:30am and 2:30 til 6:30pm.

We are located behind the fire brigade headquarters in Wilberforce, right next to Wilberforce Public School.
