Student Lunch Policy Statement

Rationale

The Colo Heights PS community is widespread and isolated. The school has access to lunch orders for students from the Colo Heights Roadhouse one day per week. On the remaining days students are encouraged to bring healthy lunches to school. At times these lunches may need reheating.

Aims and Objectives

Aims

- To allow students to eat a nutritious lunch.

Eating Time

Each lunch time will consist of a ten minute eating period during which students will sit quietly to eat their lunch. This is supervised by a member of the teaching staff.

Available Food

- On Mondays students have access to a lunch order service from the Colo Heights Roadhouse. These orders must be placed by the preceding Thursday.
- On other days students are to eat a nutritious lunch brought from home.
- If a students lunch needs to be reheated this will be done by a staff member.
- Frozen items of food will not be reheated, as it is not possible to reheat these items evenly.
- Food will be reheated to a warm temperature, not a hot temperature.
